Three easy steps to apply for your Toilet Replacement Rebate

- (1) Determine if you are eligible.
 - ☐ Your Multi-Unit building is within the city of Calgary.
 - ☐ You have removed your old 13 litre+ toilets, purchased and installed high-efficiency, WaterSense labelled toilets.
 - ☐ The unit number(s) listed on your application has not received a rebate from this program previously.
- (2) Complete the Toilet Replacement Rebate application form (including Unit Form on reverse) and mail with ORIGINAL toilet purchase receipts (for each toilet) within one year of purchase date. We recommend you make copies of your application and receipt(s) for your records.

Program terms and conditions:

This offer only applies to properties located in Calgary. Effective September 1, 2011 a toilet must have a WaterSense label to be eligible for The City of Calgary \$50 Replacement Rebate. New toilets must replace a toilet with a flush volume of 13 litres or more.

Eligible rebates are completed in 8 to 10 weeks. Applications must be submitted within one (1) year of purchase date of new toilet. Submission of application does not guarantee a rebate. Applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis. This offer may be withdrawn at any time without notice. The City of Calgary Water Services reserves the right to inspect and verify that eligible toilets are installed and old toilets made unusable. Applicants may be subject to on-site inspection and verification.

The City may forward your application form and supporting documents to a Third-Party Service Provider for review and payment where applicable. Questions or concerns regarding changes to the program administration or access to information should be directed to The City of Calgary Water Conservation Program Staff by calling 3-1-1.
